

DIRECTIONS TO DURBAN COUNTRY CLUB

Our GPS co-ordinates are as follows:

DCC GPS co-ordinates - 29° 49' 40"S, 31° 2' 2"E

Beachwood GPS co-ordinates - 29° 46' 53"S, 31° 3' 2"E

From King Shaka International Airport

On leaving the airport, follow the airport signage leading to the N2. Keeping right, proceed with the N2 Durban/Pietermaritzburg road to a tollgate where you will be required to pay R4.00. Continue along the N2, pass the Umhloti offramp, the Sibaya Casino offramp and take the next offramp which is the Umhlanga/Gateway offramp. Keep left. Turn left into the M4, move into the middle lane, pass Gateway Theatre of Shopping and various office parks on your left. Along the M4 you will pass the La Lucia, Glenashley, Virginia, Swapo and Riverside Rd offramps. After going over the Umgeni River, you will take the next off ramp which is Blue Lagoon. Turn right into Athlone, at the T-Junction keep left into Masabalala Yengwe Ave. Stay in the left hand lane pass through the 1st set of robots and at the second set of robots turn left and the Durban Country Club entrance is the next turn left.

From Cape Town via Transkei and Southern suburbs (N2 South)

Follow the South Coast freeway via Margate and Port Shepstone, past Dududu and Amanzimtoti, Keep left for N3/N2 North (The right fork takes you into Durban city centre via South Coast Road). After 8.5 km you reach a highway multi-level interchange called Spaghetti Junction. Do not turn off here. Keep on straight along the N2 North/Stanger. Follow this through to the next glide-off, Umgeni River, turn right at the traffic lights, follow the road underneath the highway bridge. This is Umgeni Road. Keep to the middle lane! At the next multi-level interchange (Connaught Bridge), you must go straight and underneath the interchange. Follow this road until you get to an intersection Smiso Nkwanyana Rd (formerly Goble Road), just before the robots take the left hand slipway into Smiso Nkwanyana Rd. Keep to the middle lane, at the traffic light (T-junction) turn right into Masabalala Yengwe Ave (formerly NMR Avenue). Keep left, at the 1st set of robots turn left into the Durban Country Club entrance.

From Cape Town via Bloemfontein (N1)

Travel on the N1 through Paarl, Worcester, Beaufort West, Colesburg to Bloemfontein. From here follow the route to Winburg through to Harrismith. Here you join the N3 to Durban. This is the main route from Johannesburg. Travelling on the N3 you will pass Howick and Pietermaritzburg. As you near Durban you will pass the Mariannhill toll plaza. From here you pass Pinetown, Westville and the big shopping complex on your right hand side called the Pavilion. Get into the leftmost traffic lane and proceed down the hill until you approach a multi-level interchange and take the N2 North/Stanger glide-off. Follow this through to the next glide-off, Umgeni River, turn right at the traffic lights, follow the road underneath the highway bridge. This is Umgeni Road. Keep to the middle lane! At the next multi-level interchange (Connaught Bridge), you must go straight and underneath the interchange. Follow this road until you get to an intersection Smiso Nkwanyana Rd (formerly Goble Road), just before the robots take the left hand slipway into Smiso Nkwanyana Rd. Keep to the middle lane, at the traffic light (T-junction) turn right into Masabalala Yengwe Ave (formerly NMR Avenue). From Johannesburg/Gauteng (N3)

Travelling on the N3 you will pass Howick and Pietermaritzburg. As you near Durban you will pass the Mariannhill toll plaza. From here you pass Pinetown, Westville and the big shopping complex on your right hand side called the Pavilion. Get into the leftmost traffic lane and proceed down the hill until you approach a multi-level interchange and take the N2 North/Stanger glide-off. Follow this through to the next glide-off, Umgeni River, turn right at the traffic lights, follow the road underneath the highway bridge. This is Umgeni Road. Keep to the middle lane! At the next multi-level interchange (Connaught Bridge), you must go straight and underneath the interchange. Follow this road until you get to an intersection Smiso Nkwanyana Rd (formerly Goble Road), just before the robots take the left hand slipway into Smiso Nkwanyana Rd. Keep to the middle lane, at the traffic light (T-junction) turn right into Masabalala Yengwe Ave (formerly NMR Avenue). From Spaghetti Junction

Coming from either the City centre, the Northern suburbs or Southern suburbs, take the N2 North/Stanger highway and follow this through to the next glide-off, turn right at the traffic lights, follow the road underneath the highway bridge. This is Umgeni Road. Keep to the middle lane! At the next multi-level interchange (Connaught Bridge), you must go straight and underneath the interchange. Follow this road until you get to an intersection Smiso Nkwanyana Rd (formerly Goble Road), just before the robots take the left hand slipway into Smiso Nkwanyana Rd. Keep to the middle lane, at the traffic light (T-junction) turn right into Masabalala Yengwe Ave (formerly NMR Avenue). From Richards Bay/Northern KZN (N2 North)

Come in along the cement dual carriageway on the N2 and you will eventually find the Inanda Rd/Umgeni Rd turnoff. At the top of the glide-off you need to go straight across the traffic light intersection. You will now find yourself traveling parallel to the N2 highway. At the bottom of the incline is a set of traffic lights where you turn left into Umgeni Road. Keep to the middle lane! At the next multi-level interchange (Connaught Bridge), you must go straight and underneath the interchange. Follow this road until you get to an intersection Smiso Nkwanyana Rd (formerly Goble Road), just before the robots take the left hand slipway into Smiso Nkwanyana Rd. Keep to the middle lane, at the traffic light (T-junction) turn right into Masabalala Yengwe Ave (formerly NMR Avenue). From Umgeni River turnoff

Keep to the middle lane! At the next multi-level interchange (Connaught Bridge), you must go straight and underneath the interchange. Follow this road until you get to an intersection Smiso Nkwanyana Rd (formerly Goble Road), just before the robots take the left hand slipway into Smiso Nkwanyana Rd. Keep to the middle lane, at the traffic light (T-junction) turn right into Masabalala Yengwe Ave (formerly NMR Avenue). From the KZN North Coast resorts (Umhlanga/Ballito etc)

You will be traveling along the Ruth First (North Coast) freeway. As you pass over the Umgeni River, keep left and take the turnoff immediately after the bridge called Blue Lagoon. At the yield, turn right into Athlone Rd and proceed underneath the highway. On your left is the Country Club Course 6th hole. Keep left and at the next intersection turn left into Masabalala Yengwe Ave (formerly NMR Avenue). Keep left, at the 1st set of robots turn left and left again into the Durban Country Club entrance

From Northern Suburbs

Find and proceed down Northway - this is the main road that links the Northern suburbs with the city. Pass over the Umgeni River and keep in the left lane. As you pass through the traffic lights, it becomes Masabalala Yengwe Ave (formerly NMR Avenue). Keep left, at the 1st set of robots turn left and left again into the Durban Country Club entrance

From City Centre

There are many roads to use, but for the visitor, the easiest will be to find West Street (one-way travelling towards the sea/beachfront). Find the Aliwal Street intersection, and turn left (North). Continue with this road until you pass the Kingsmead Cricket Grounds. This road now becomes Masabalala Yengwe Ave (formerly NMR Avenue). Keep to the right hand lane and follow this road until you see the swimming pool complex on your right and the iconic Moses Mabhida Stadium on your left. At the first set of robots after the stadium, turn right into Isaiah Ntshangase Rd (formerly Walter Gilbert) and the Club's entrance is on your left hand side.

To the Beachwood Course

From Country Club, exit the main gates, and turn left – this will take you to the Ruth First Freeway (M4). Continue over the Umgeni River, past the Riverside Rd turnoff, you will also pass the Pick n Pay Hyper on your left. Keep to the left hand lane. Take the Swapo (Durban North) turnoff, about 1.3 km after the river. Be careful here - as you come off the highway reduce speed. There is a yield sign where you must turn right onto and over the bridge, and then turn immediately left after the bridge at a sign which reads "Fairway". There are numerous speed bumps along the road. Follow this for approximately 1.8 km to a sign that reads "Durban Country Club - Beachwood Course" and turn right down Beachwood Place where the clubhouse facilities are on your left about 80 meters further on down this lane.
